Per Article 7 of New York State Agriculture and Markets Law:

All dogs, 4 months of age and older living in the Town of Leyden are required by New York State, to be licensed at the Town of Leyden's Clerks office. Application must be submitted at the Office of the Town Clerk or by mail. New York State requires proof of the current rabies vaccination. If the dog is spayed or neutered, documentation must be presented for the reduced fee.

The license is renewable each year. A renewal notice will be sent to the owner from the Office of the Town Clerk. The Dog Identification Tag, issued with the license is permanent. If the tag is lost, a replacement can be ordered through the office of the Town Clerk.

2. Either mail or hand-deliver to the Office of the Town Clerk – address above.

Application must include:

- a. check or money order payable to the Town of Leyden Clerk
- b. proof of current rabies vaccination
- c. proof of spay/neuter (required for reduced fee)
