Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2002

MISCELLANEOUS

A Local Law abolishing the office of elected assessors and establishing the position of a Single Appointed Assessor for the Town of Leyden.

(Insert Title)

Be it enacted by the **Town Board** of the **Town of Leyden**, as follows:

Section 1. Legislative Intent

The purpose of this Local Law is to establish the office of a single appointed assessor, and to terminate the office of elected assessors.

Section 2.

This Local Law hereby repeals Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1971, pursuant to which the Town of Leyden retained the offices of elected assessors.

Section 3.

The terms of office for the three elected assessors for the Town of Leyden shall terminate on September 3, 2002.

Section 4.

There is hereby established, the office of a single appointed assessor, effective October 1, 2002. The initial term of office shall expire on September 30, 2007. Thereafter, the terms for the appointive assessor shall commence on the first of October, 2007 and each sixth year thereafter in accordance with Real Property Tax Law Section 310.

Section 5.

This Local Law is adopted in accordance with the provisions of Section 328 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.

Section 6.

This Local Law is subject to a permissive referendum in the manner prescribed in Section 24 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.

Section 7.

This Local Law shall take effect 45 days after its adoption and all legal requirements being met, and upon it being filed in the Office of the Secretary of State.

Such Local Law was submitted to the people by reason of a permissive referendum, and received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon at the general/special/annual election held on _____, 1999, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.

4. (Subject to a Permissive Referendum and Final Adoption Because No Valid Petition was Filed Requesting Referendum.)

I hereby certify that the Local Law annexed hereto, designated as Local Law No. 2 of 2002, of the Town of Leyden, was duly passed by the Town Board of the Town of Leyden on July 9, 2002, and was approved by the Town Board of the Town of Leyden on July 9, 2002. Such Local Law was subject to permissive referendum and no valid petition requesting such referendum was filed as of August 24, 2002, in accordance with the applicable provisions of law.

* Elective Chief Executive Officer means or includes the chief executive officer of a county elected on a county-wide basis, or if there be none, the chairman of the county legislative body, the mayor of a city or village, or the supervisor of a town where such officer is vested with the power to approve or veto Local Laws or Ordinances.

5. (City Local Law Concerning Charter Revision Proposed by Petition.)

I hereby certify that the Local Law annexed hereto, designated as Local Law No. _____ of 19__, of the County of _____, State of New York, having been submitted to the electors at the General Election of November _____, 19__, pursuant to the subdivisions 5 and 7 of Section 33 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, and having received the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the cities of said county as a unit and of a majority of the qualified electors of the towns of said county considered as a unit voting at said general election, became operative.


